Creative Europe is the European Commission's framework programme for support to the European culture and audiovisual sectors. In the framework of our Culture Subprogramme - Cooperation scheme, MoTA's project « MAPs – Mapping and Archiving Public Spaces » was selected in 2017 and is now in its first year of implementation.

Creative Europe's support to the selected projects is based on a principle of co-financing: Creative Europe's grant for MAPS represents 56,76% of the total financing. The beneficiary is therefore in charge of funding the project for the remaining 43,24% of the total budget. Without this share of co-financing - which is a contractual obligation for MoTA - the project would encounter big difficulties and run the risk of falling by the wayside.

It has to be underlined that MAPS's objectives specifically address the topic of cultural heritage which is at the heart of the ongoing celebrations of 2018 European Year of Cultural Heritage.

In this context, as the executive Agency in charge of the management of Creative Europe for the European Commission, we pay particular attention to the good implementation of the awarded projects and strongly hope that all conditions will be gathered for the successful fulfilment of MAPS' objectives.
